

CONDUCT IN THE DOJANG/TRAINING AREA

The Instructor has the right to refuse Instruction to any individual at their discretion

- 1 Bow to the Instructor and when entering and leaving the training area. This is to show respect and modesty
- 2 Do not enter or leave the class without permission from your instructor
- 3 Students must bow always before speaking to the instructor and use words of consideration while speaking such as: yes Sir, no Sir, Pardon Me, Ma'am or Mr/Mrs/Miss
- 4 All students are expected to be courteous and understanding. Advanced students are expected to set a good example to new students and assist such students whenever necessary
- 5 Loud conversation, laughing in excess and chewing gum eating and drinking have no place in a Martial Arts school
- 6 Your uniform should be clean at all times turn around and adjust your uniform neatly prior to class ending
- 7 Any substitute teacher should be treated as your regular teacher
- 8 Do not give a demonstration or teach without the approval of your instructor
- 9 Do not engage in any activity that might degrade the code of Martial Arts ethics or the reputation of the school
- 10 You must have the approval of the instructor before participating in any tournament
- 11 Your licence must be renewed 1 month before it expires
- 12 You must hand in your grading record sheet prior to each grading
- 13 Only approved equipment or clothing purchased from your instructor may be worn in class or at tournaments
- 14 No jewellery may be worn during training and soft hair bands only to be used
- 15 Grading will depend on attendance and at the Instructors discretion
